
I am requesting funding for the Water and Wastewater System Improvements for the City of Madison, FL in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Madison, located at 321 SW Rutledge St, Madison, FL 32340.

The funding would be used to complete water and wastewater system improvements, consisting of line replacements along County Camp Road and Bunker Street. The City is facing critical infrastructure challenges that threaten the reliability, efficiency, and financial sustainability of its municipal system. The existing water and sewer lines in this corridor are aging and in need of replacement to prevent service disruptions, reduce the risk of leaks and sanitary sewer overflows, and ensure continued compliance with state and federal environmental standards. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds it will upgrade the infrastructure and improve system reliability, protect public health, and safeguard local water quality. Replacing deteriorated lines will also reduce long-term maintenance costs, improve operational efficiency, and strengthen the resilience of essential public utilities serving residents and businesses.

This project has a federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized in Section 306 of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, 7 U.S. Code section 1926(a)(2).
