
I am requesting funding for the Fire/Crash Station at Tyndall AFB in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Tyndall AFB, located at 103 Mississippi Ave, Tyndall AFB, Florida, 32403.

The funding would be used for a fire/crash station. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because that station utilizes economical design and construction methods to accommodate the mission of the facility. The new facility includes crash/fire rescue station with multiple drive-through bays. Construction will include concrete slab on grade, 8" concrete masonry unit walls, metal standing seamless roof and all necessary climate resiliency measures. The facility includes a 500 KW generator and is authorized by Air Force Manual 32-1062. The project includes utilities, pavements, communications support, emergency generator, site improvements, soil remediation, and other supporting work necessary to make a complete and usable facility. Facilities will be designed as permanent construction in accordance with the Department of Defense Unified Facilities Criteria 1-200-01, General Building Requirements.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 10 U.S.C. Chapter 169.
