As you begin crafting the fiscal year 2025 (FY2023) appropriations bill, I respectfully request that you consider the following community funding priorities:

1. Project InSPIRE project funding request for \$5,000,000
2. Gulf Coast State College Simulation Training Center project funding request for \$3,000,000.
3. TLH Resiliency and Advanced Air Mobility project funding request for \$2,970,000
4. Panama City Beach Florida Water System Redundancy Project Phase 2 funding request for \$4,402,944.
5. Provide an additional \$48,000,000 in FY 25 funding to Tyndall AFB, Fire, Crash, Rescue Station (XLWU253001) (Unfunded Priorities List).
6. Provide a funding level of \$ 5,000,000 for a community project funding request. The intended recipient is the Taylor County Board of County Commissioners located at 201 E. Green St. Perry, FL 32347. The project would provide a valuable fire station and public safety facility.
7. Provide a funding level of \$2,000,000 for a community project funding request. The intended recipient is Florida A&M University located at 1601 S. Martin Luther King Blvd, Tallahassee, FL 32307. The project would provide a valuable community food business incubator.
8. Provide a funding level of \$500,000 for a community project funding request. The intended recipient is the Taylor County Board of County Commissioners located at 201 E. Green Street, Perry, FL 32347. The project would provide a valuable fire station and public safety facility.
9. Tallahassee Police Department Training Facility Indoor Tactical Firing Range Equipment project funding request for \$4,258,247 in FY 2025 to purchase equipment for use in a state-of-the-art Law Enforcement Training Facility at the new Tallahassee Police Department Headquarters.
10. FSU- Nano- Manufacturing and Material Analysis Cleanroom project funding request for \$ 4,800,000 in FY 25 to purchase equipment that will be used in a state-of-the-art nano-

manufacturing and quantum device fabrication and research lab. This lab will provide essential hands-on, high-quality training for the micro-electronic manufacturing workforce of the future.

11. Jackson County Community Outreach Center project funding request for \$2,500,000 in FY 2025 to construct a Community Outreach Center for Jackson County.
12. Effluent Conveyance Replacement and Upgrade project funding request for \$3,000,000
13. Bay County Subaqueous Water Main at Dupont Bridge project funding request for \$4,500,000
14. Sunny Hills Water/Sewer Infrastructure Improvements project funding request for \$5,300,000
15. Gadsden County and City of Quincy Water System Improvement and Expansion project funding request for \$4,500,000
